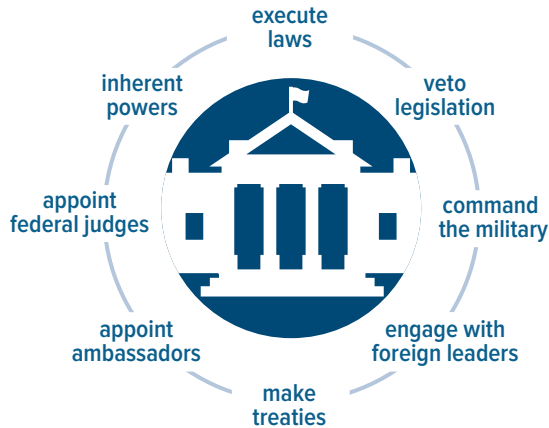

performs ceremonial functions	carries out the laws
comforts citizens in times of crisis	appoints Cabinet and other agency heads
hosts dignitaries	appoints federal judges and Supreme Court justices
gives awards to distinguished citizens	issues executive orders
	grants reprieves, pardons, and amnesty

As civilian commander of the armed forces, can use the military to	directs U.S. foreign policy
defend the nation	makes decisions about U.S. relations with other countries
engage in overseas operations	negotiates and signs treaties
control serious turmoil in the United States	signs executive agreements with other countries
aid in natural disasters in the United States	recognizes foreign governments

ECONOMIC PLANNER
submits annual budget to Congress
submits economic reports to Congress
appoints heads of Federal Reserve System

PARTY LEADER
gives speeches and attends fundraisers to support party candidates
selects party's national chair
helps plan election strategies
appoints party members to political office
